Building Code: internally illuminated exit lights are to be illuminated at all times and connected to an emergency power supply. If the exit signs are self contained they are to be constructed to CSA C22..2 No 141.

This means that the battery pack is subjected to the same annual inspection, testing and maintenance as emergency lighting as it forms part of the exiting system. In most cases exit lights draw back up power from another unit such as an emergency light pack or on a system in which the circuit has a central power unit.

On a self-contained exit sign an annual tag would therefore be expected. If part of a system then only the source battery pack would need to be tagged.
